



Bulgarian Armed Forces Colonel Dimitre Minchev, PhD works as military historian, President Bulgarian National Commission of Military History (BNCMH).

He started his career as a field artillery platoon commander after graduating a military school; from 1969-1974 worked as a military diplomat in Belgrade, Yugoslavia.

After a short service as a battalion commander, from 1981 on, Colonel Minchev works as a military historian. His career is marked with a couple of scientific volumes, translated in English, and a lot of articles, mainly on the Macedonian Question.

In 1995 was raised as Chief of the Institute of Military History. In 1997 obtained Masters degree from National Defense University, Industrial College of the Armed Forces, Washington, DC, USA. In 1998 was granted the title of Honorary Professor by the Russian Academy of Natural Sciences.

Colonel Minchev did his best in popularizing the Bulgarian Military History abroad after organizing a lot of international events in our country, and supporting Bulgarian membership in international organizations such as PfP Consortium of Defense Academies. Due to his enormous efforts, in 2012 and 2014 Bulgaria witnessed the World Congresses of the International Commission of Military History, a UNESCO organizations

August 1 in Fulda, Germany started his work as the CIOR Director Symposium for the term 2014-2016.

Colonel Minchev was organized four international congresses of Military History in Bulgaria so far.

He is very acting member of Association of the Officers of the Reserve "Atlantic" in Bulgaria.
